- The receiving institution will send its decision within 6-8 weeks after deadline.
- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- Termination of the agreement. It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

German grading system

German universities (except for law schools) a 1 to 5 scale is used:

- 1,0-1,3 sehr gut (very good: an *outstanding* achievement)
- 1,7-2,3 gut (good: an achievement which lies *substantially above average* requirements)
- 2,7-3,3 befriedigend (satisfactory: an achievement which corresponds to *average* requirements)
- 3,7-4,0 ausreichend (sufficient: an achievement which *barely meets* the requirements)
- 4,3-5,0 nicht ausreichend / nicht bestanden (not sufficient / failed: an achievement which *does not meet* the requirements)

2. Visa
